The artwork on display in our lobby is part of the Art Raffle fundraising project held the past nine years for Big Brothers/Big Sisters here in Austin. Area artists have devoted their time and talent for this fundraising event which will give financial support to Big Brothers/Big Sisters. Our bank has on display just eight of the pieces for this years event. If you wish to see the others just drop by one of the main downtown banks . . . the artwork should be displayed in their lobbies.

Big Brothers opened their doors in 1971 for fatherless boys in our community. Since that time more than 3,000 boys have benefited from Big Brothers. In 1975 the Big Brothers program enlarged to its format to include Big Sisters. The purpose of this program is to help children from all parts of the city, from every socio-economic level to develop one-on-one relationships.

The 1982 Annual Art Raffle will be held on Saturday, June 12th. Those interested in attending should contact Big Brothers/Big Sisters for more details. Raffle tickets will cost \$75 for a single and \$100 for a couple. Artwork will be raffled at the banquet.

Currently there are 95 children waiting for their own Big Brother or Big Sister. With the continued support of the community Big Brothers/Big Sisters will reach their goals.
