

First City has introduced a new service ... FirstNet Point-of-Sale Services, an electronic point-of-sale service for retailers. Retailers who subscribe to the P.O.S. Services will be able to offer their customers a new method of payment with ATM debit cards, and a more efficient method of operation for credit cards and travel and entertainment cards. In addition, retailers will be able to reduce paperwork, improve funds flow, and virtually eliminate charge backs due to unauthorized or fraudulent use of credit cards.

First City Bancorporation of Texas and BUYPASS The System, Inc. have

signed an exclusive agreement to offer this comprehensive electronic P.O.S. services package to retailers throughout Texas. BUYPASS The System, Inc. is the nation's first electronic payment authorization system with the ability to link major credit cards and debit cards, as well as fleet cards (vehicle drivers to use a fleet debit card for purchase of gas and merchandise).



FirstNet Update

As of December 1, 1984, Austin CableVision subscribers are able to pay their monthly cable bills at any of the 17 FirstNet locations throughout Austin. In addition to 24-hour payment convenience, subscribers who utilize the FirstNet ATMs will receive a printed acknowledgment of the time, date, and location where the payment was made. When making the CableVision payment, only checks and money orders will be accepted. For faster processing, subscribers are encouraged to remit their payments in the envelope provided with their cable bill. This service is provided to Austin CableVision subscribers at no charge.

Our main objective in offering this new capability is to provide additional payment centers for the 88,000+ households that subscribe to Austin CableVision. Because most households have an ATM card of one kind or another, the marketing objective is to increase customer traffic at all FirstNet locations. Keeping this in mind, when the customer makes their payment, they will be asked if they want to make another transaction; hopefully they will try our FirstNet machines for cash withdrawals. Remember, FirstNet locations accept all PULSE cards, and now MPACT cardholders can use FirstNet.

So remember, and pass along, that you can pay your CableVision bill here ... FIRSTNET
