Austin Adopt-A-School

This Fall kicks off First City's 4th year of involvement with the

Adopt-A-School Program and this should prove to be an extra special year for Adopt-A-School and First City with John Scurlock as this year's Chairman of Adopt-A-School.

As a result of First City's dedication to this worthwhile community effort and in recognition of excellence in the Adopt-A-School Program, we have been awarded the first "A+ Award" by the Austin Chamber of Commerce and the Austin Independent School District. First City has been recognized for the last three years for its "outstanding contribution and involvement" with our adopted schools. 
